An ENG 3 form will be issued if a Restriction has been placed on this ENG 1 form. If you wish to request a medical review by a Medical Referee, you will need to complete the ENG 3 form within one month of the examination date and forward to the address below.
4. By signing the certificate you are confirming that you have fully disclosed your medical history / conditions to the Approved Doctor.
5. Not complying with the terms of a condition of issue of this certificate, or failure to disclose significant change in your medical fitness (to an MCA Approved Doctor) while holding this certificate could result in the certificate being suspended or cancelled by the Approved Doctor on behalf of the Maritime and Coastguard Agency (Regulation 13 of SI 2010/737 and Regulation 9 of SI 2018/1108)
6. If you are off sick for more than 30 days or your medical fitness changes significantly in accordance with MIN 701, you should contact an Approved Doctor (preferably the one who issued the certificate) for medical review. (Regulation 12 of SI 2010/737 and Regulation 9 of SI 2018/1108)
7. This certificate **must be surrendered** to the Approved Doctor when attending your next medical examination.
8. It is an offence to tamper with, alter or falsify this certificate in any way, and you could be prosecuted if you do.
